Do we believe every word of the Bible? The answer is yes! We believe every word of the Bible and we believe that every word is in fact inspired by God the Holy Spirit. As followers of Christ, we should have no problem believing and affirming that very truth. It is often in the application process that we find the difficulty. It is monumentally important that we not only believe every word of the Bible, but that we seek to apply His word faithfully each day. James would tell us to not only believe each word, but that real faith applies the word we believe. How are you seeking to apply God's word in your personal life? How are you seeking to apply God's word in your home? How are we seeking to apply God's word at Silo Baptist Church?

These questions are being answered as we work our way through 1 Timothy on Sunday nights. We are taking a serious look at God's word and as we do, we must strongly consider the application process of the word. The world would have us believe that 1 Timothy is all 1st Century beliefs and therefore, it does not apply to today. The problems with that are two-fold.

- 1. They are LYING. All of 1 Timothy applies to the church today.
2. "The grass withers and the flower fades, but the WORD OF OUR GOD STANDS FOREVER" (Isaiah 40:8).

Do not be deceived, loved ones, the devil's tactics have not changed. He is still trying to get man to question the validity of God's word. "Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world" (1 Peter 5:9).
